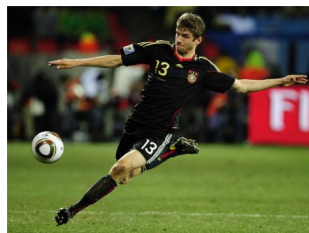


Week 7 & 8

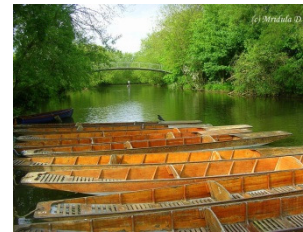
