Talk: Prof Rupert Stadler, CEO of Audi AG

Rupert Stadler was born in 1963 in Tittling (Bavaria), and studied Business Management at Augsburg University of Applied Sciences. After graduating, Stadler started his career at Philips Kommunikation Industrie AG in Nuremberg. He joined AUDI AG, Ingolstadt, in 1990, and became Chairman of the Board of Management of AUDI AG in 2007,



after holding several executive positions at Audi's parent company Volkswagen AG. In November 2012, Rupert Stadler was appointed an honorary professor for Business Administration by the University of St. Gallen. **Note: The talk will be held in English**.

Talk: Barbara Salesch, Judge, television star, artist Thur, 14th May, 6pm, Blue Boar Lecture Theatre, Christ Church

Barbara Salesch studied law, and became a judge in 1979. In 1991, she was appointed presiding judge at the Hamburg County Court. On the suggestion of the president of the Hamburg County Court, she auditioned for the position of a television court judge and was immediately accepted. The show Richterin Barbara Salesch influenced German afternoon television for 12 years. In 2002, it won the German Television Award



for best daily programme. After more than 2400 episodes, Salesch ended her television career in 2012 to devote herself primarily to her art work. **Note: The talk will be held in German.**
