Talk: Carsten Spohr, CEO of Lufthansa

Carsten Spohr has been Chairman of the Executive Board and Chief



Executive Officer of Deutsche Lufthansa AG since May 1, 2014. In this role, he is responsible for the Lufthansa Group, which comprises the Passenger Airline Group, Logistics, MRO, Catering and IT Services segments and has around 117,000

employees worldwide. He holds a degree in industrial engineering from Karlsruhe University, and qualified for a commercial airline pilot's license from the Lufthansa Flight Training school in Bremen and Phoenix. Carsten Spohr holds a Lufthansa captain's license for the aircraft of the Airbus A320 family. In May 2014, he was part of an international delegation of business leaders invited to the White House by US president Barack Obama to discuss the aim of extending job opportunities from international companies to the US.
